In the meantime, it is very important that you submit by the priority deadline, <u>September 30</u>, the following:

- (1) Admissions application (completed)
- (2) High school transcript (official)

All college entrance exams are due by November 7, 2020.

(1) \*SAT (FAMU SAT code is 5215) or \*\*ACT test scores (FAMU ACT code is 0726)

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, additional dates have been added. For the fall, the new test dates are listed below. We advocate taking either of these college entrance exams to meet our November 7 test date, deadline.
