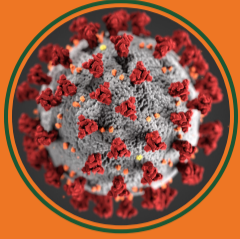

Fall 2021 Quick Guide



1 Get Ready

Visit the University's website and check your email regularly for updates guiding your Fall 2021 return.



2 Get Vaccinated!

Vaccination is **STRONGLY** encouraged. FAMU's free vaccination site, located at 674 Gamble Street (near the intersection of Perry and Gamble Streets) is a convenient option. Simply walk up, get your shot, and go. Remember to keep your vaccination card!



3 Return Kits

Return kits for faculty, staff, and students are available. Department reps may contact Rica Calhoun (rica.calhoun@famu.edu) to arrange pick up.



5 Wear a Face Covering

Faculty, staff, students, and visitors are expected to wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth when in classrooms, buildings and in public spaces. This includes the dining halls and the libraries. Face coverings are available upon request.

4 Screen Yourself

Self-screen daily using the COVID-19 Self-Checker on the FAMU mobile app and temperature kiosks around campus. Free COVID-19 testing is available at Bragg Memorial Stadium. Stay home if you are sick!



6 Classes, Residence Life, and Events

Classes and residence hall capacity will return to normal. University events will also resume, with safety in mind.



7 Remember Your Hygiene

Wash hands frequently. Use soap and warm water and wash for at least 20 seconds. If water is unavailable, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
