**NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATION**

**DATE:** December 4, 2014

**REGULATION CHAPTER NO.:** Chapter 4

**REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE:** Academic Affairs

**REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER:** Students in Military Service (4.107)

**SUMMARY OF REGULATION:** This new regulation ensures any student, while enrolled at Florida A&M University, called to or enlisted in active military service shall not incur academic or financial penalties for performance of active military service on behalf of the United States of America.

**AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION:** Section 7, Article IX, Florida Constitution and Board of Governors Regulations 1.001 and 6.013.

**UNIVERSITY OFFICIAL INITIATING THIS REGULATION:** Rodner B. Wright, Interim Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

**FULL TEXT OF THE PROPOSED REGULATION:** The full text of this new regulation follows:

**Regulations of  
Florida A&M University**



**4.107 Students in Military Service**

- (1) Any student, while enrolled at Florida A&M University, called to or enlisted in active military service shall not incur academic or financial penalties for performance of active military service on behalf of the United States of America.
  - (a) Active military service means active duty verified by official orders or appropriate military certification with any branch of the United States Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, National Guard of the State of Florida, or other service as provided in the Florida Statutes.
- (2) Such student shall be permitted the option of either completing the course or courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the student chooses to withdraw, the student's academic record shall reflect that the withdrawal was due to active military service.
